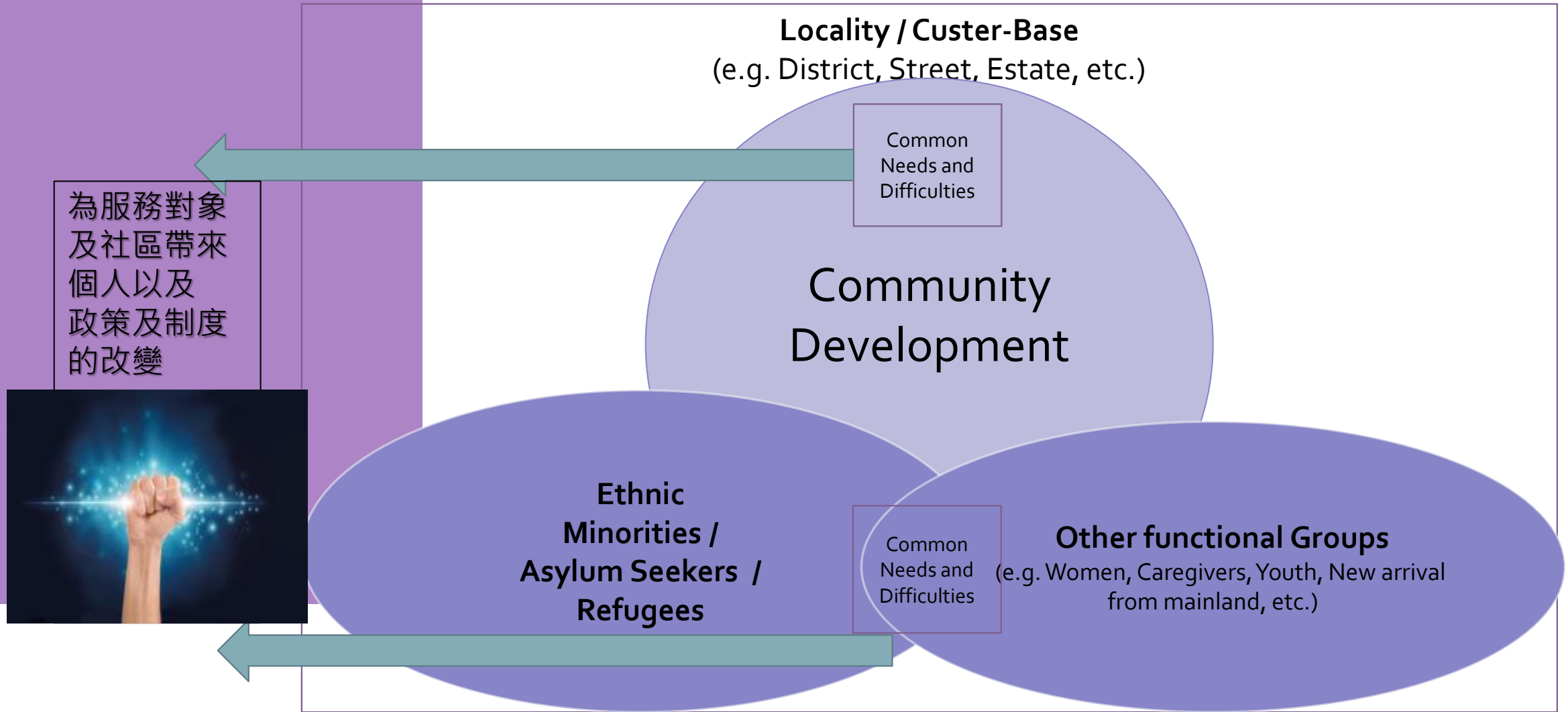

4. 政府經濟顧問辦公室比對過往《香港貧窮情況報告》的相關分析後，利用政府統計處的2021年人口普查統計數據¹，嘗試從多個方面（包括住戶特徵、就業及收入情況、受惠於政府現金福利的情況、居住環境（例如人均居所樓面面積）、租金負擔，以及撫養負擔（例如每戶平均兒童人數））審視不同社會經濟特徵的住戶群組。

5. 分析結果發現，居於分間樓宇單位（俗稱「劏房」²）住戶（約214 200人）、**單親住戶**（約213 300人）³及長者住戶（約555 300人）⁴，合共約950 800人⁵，在部分選定面向的表現明顯較為遜色，其中部分住戶也有較高機會需要針對性支援。下文闡述這三個群組的多面向分析（相關統計數據分別載於**附件一**），從中反映他們較需要關顧或支援的範疇。

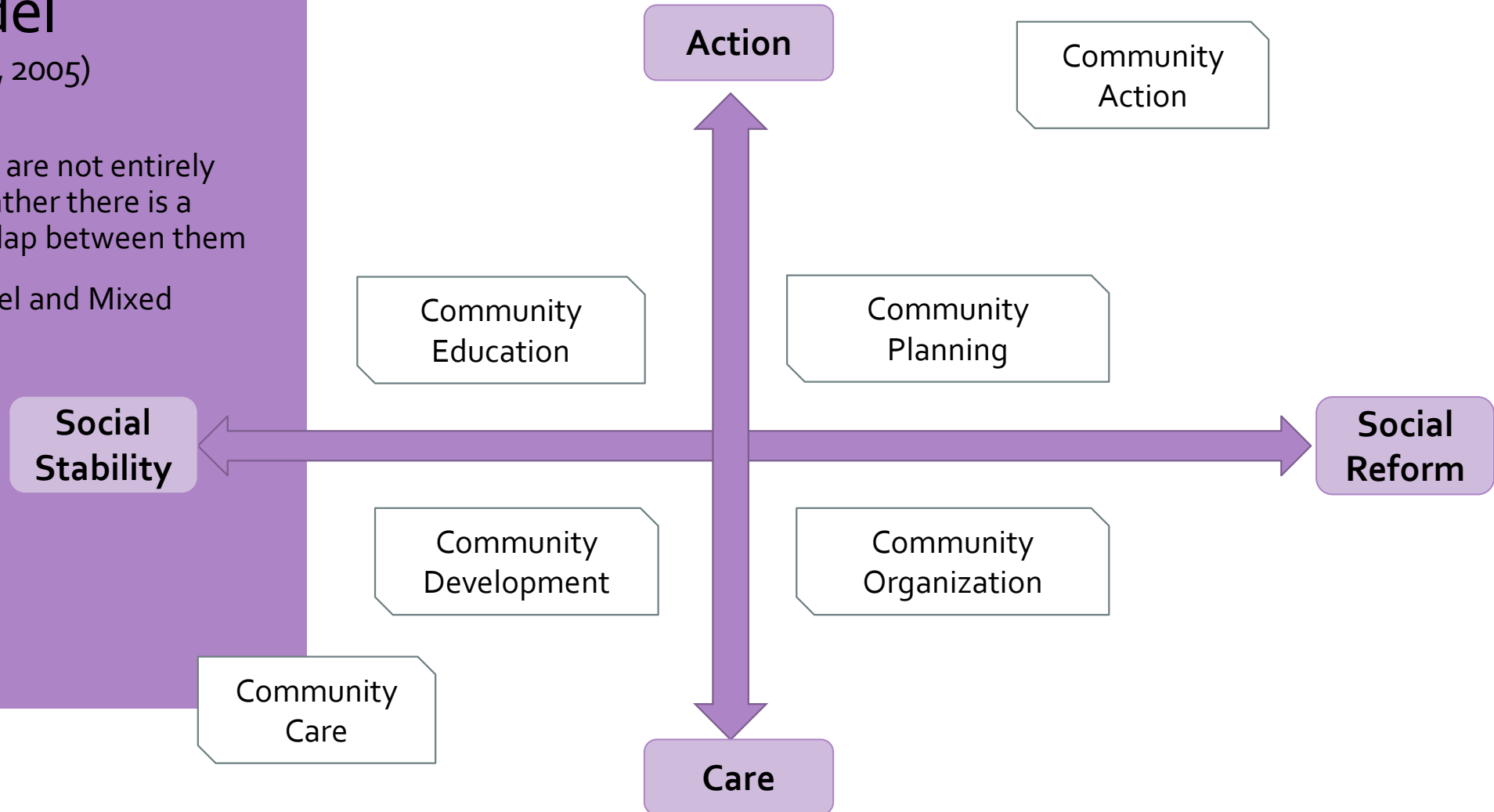

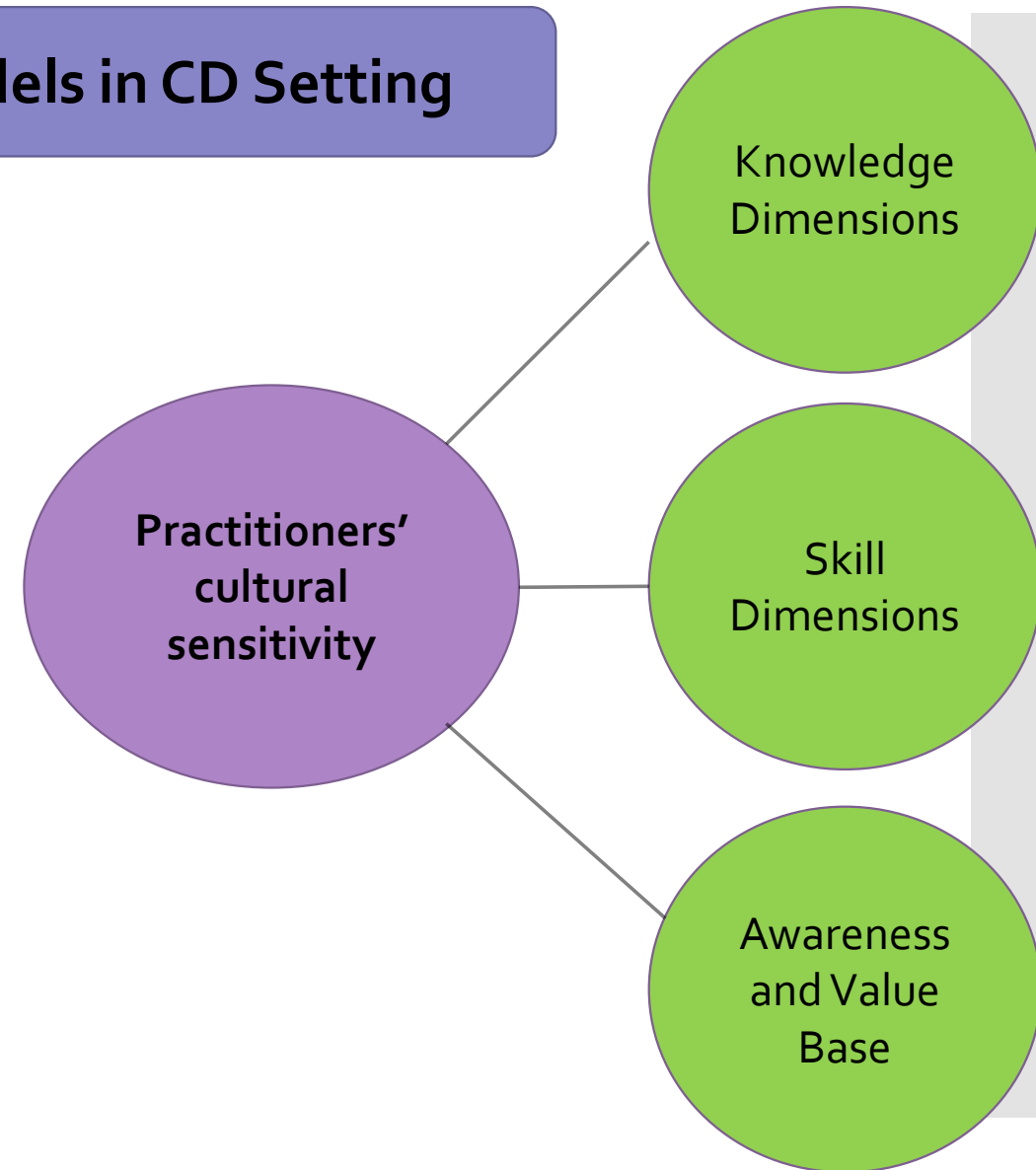
圖一：全世界的社區發展實踐中的共通主題

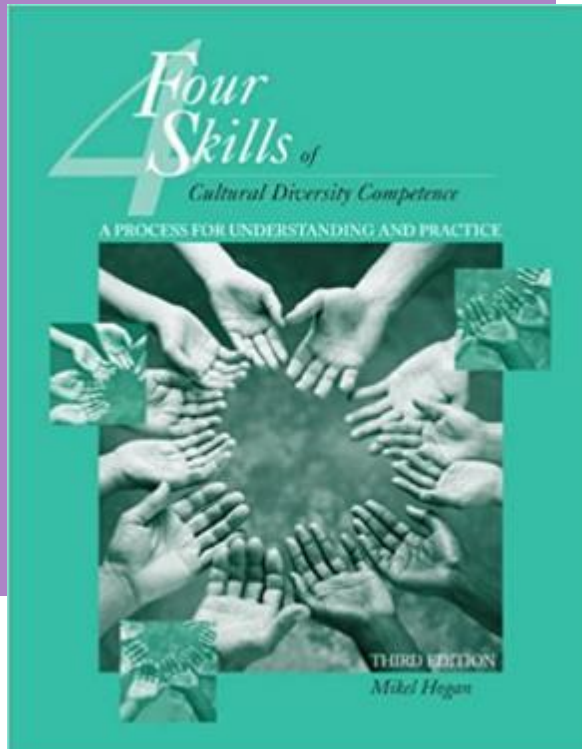

One-Day Professional Training for Practitioners 4 skills of Cultural Diversity Competence

Hong Kong has always had an ethnically diverse population. According to the 2021 census, there were over 600,000 non-Chinese people in Hong Kong or about 8.4% of the population. Chinese workers in welfare settings are ready to serve them. At the same time, many front-line practitioners from diverse ethnic backgrounds are serving people including Chinese in the community.

Competence on cultural diversity is the ability of a person to effectively interact, work, and develop relationships with people of diverse cultural backgrounds. As collaborated with Professor Mikel Hogan, Department Chair at California State University Fullerton, we are delivering a customized competence training on cultural diversity. By the end of the training, the social work practitioners will be able to increase awareness, knowledge and skills of cultural sensitivity in serving people with diverse cultural backgrounds.

Content of the training will cover four essential skills of

1. Understanding culture as multilevel
2. Understanding the six barriers
3. Practicing culturally humility in working with clients and interpreters
4. Designing and Implementing organizational-culture competence

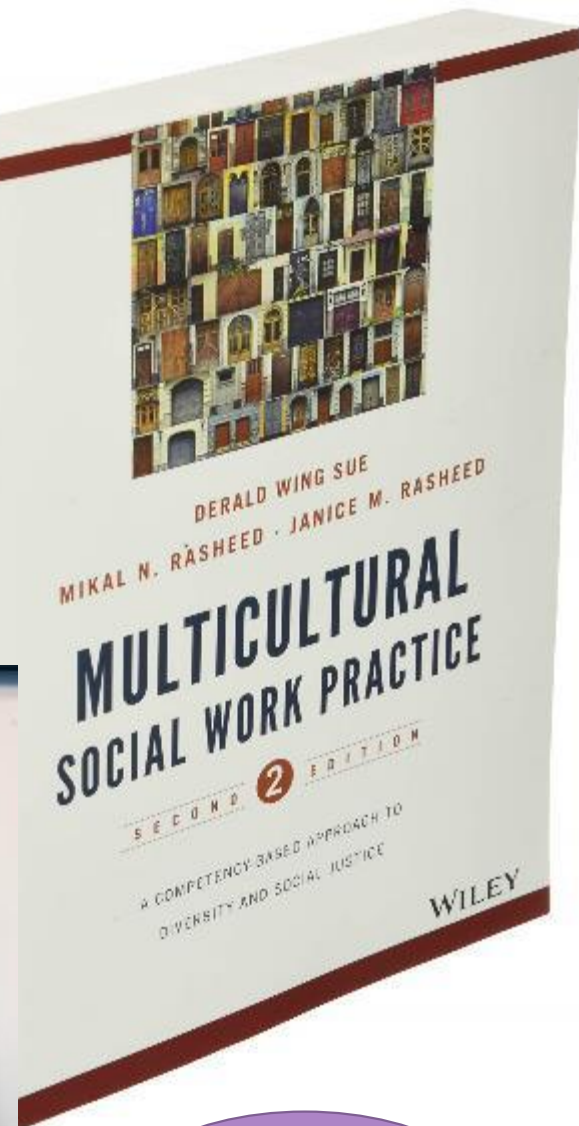
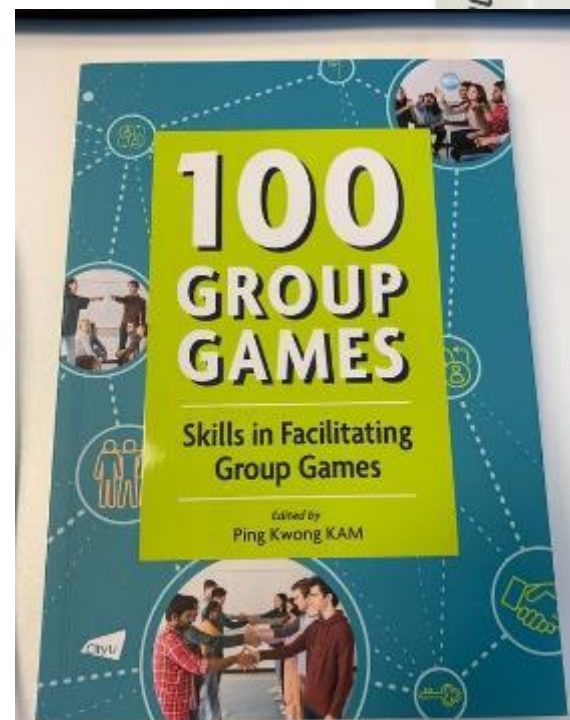
