Placement opportunities

- MSSU
- MSP



Target Group:

- Patients (In-patients, outpatients)
- Family members & caregivers
- Volunteers (ex-patients, community)



Nature and Purpose of Services of MSSU

- Pre-admission assessment and planning
- Psychosocial assessment to form holistic treatment plan
- Supportive and therapeutic counselling
- Referrals for tangible assistance
- Statuary services
- Outreaching services
- Discharge planning and follow-up service
- Advocacy of patients' rights and mobilization of community resources
- Consultation/ collaboration with inter-disciplinary team
- Organization and facilitation of educational/ supportive/ mutual-help/ therapeutic group and programmes
- Assist in empirical research



Counselling service

 Adjustment/acceptance to illnesses, aging and disabilities

Losses: organs, body parts, bodily functioning, roles, dignity, abilities, self-esteem, hope.

Threats and changes: daily functioning, interpersonal relationship



Counselling service

- Family problems
 communication blockages, family
 conflicts, caregivers' stress, financial
 hardship, new roles and expectations
- Family violence
 Physical, psychological, emotional
 Identification, screening, referral



Counselling service

Bereavement

Anticipatory grief and preparation for impending death in palliative care units, hospice centre and life threatening illnesses

Follow-up the bereaved families after death in bereavement support



Tangible service

- Help giving information, screening and referrals of the following tangible services:
- Financial (CSSA/DA/HAD,OAA, trust fund, special grant, medical waivers etc)
- Information on placement (Home transfer, Spilt tenancy, CR, Emergency shelter, old aged home)



Tangible service

- Elderly long term care plan

 (community services to placement in homes)
- Employment and training (supported employment, sheltered workshop)
- Community rehabilitation services (home-help, escort, helpful resources, Apps, self-help organization etc.)



Discharge / Rehab. plan

- Plan discharges and discuss rehab plan with inter-disciplinary team
- Referral of community resources e.g. home help, day care centre, patients' self-help organizations, health management resources and Apps and volunteer visitation services



Outreaching service

- Outreaching teams for elderly and psychiatric patients
- Early Assessment Services for Young People with Psychosis (EASY) team



Statutory service

- Mental Health Ordinance
- Court report
- Care and protection of children
- Guardianship



Groups / Programmes Services

- Therapeutic group, supportive group, mutual help group for patient and caregivers
- Psychoeducational and psychosocial programmes for patients or families
- Community educational programme and collaborations



Nature and Purpose of Services of Special Projects

- To provide service to patients and relatives in the diagnosis, treatment, pre-discharge, rehab. and/or palliative care phases
- To enhance self-help and mutual help capacity among patients and their caregivers
- To enable the optimal use of available resources in improving the quality of life of patients through referral and networking



Nature and Purpose of Services of Special Projects

- To mobilize volunteers among patients, professional groups and the community to assist in patient care
- Patients with the following illnesses or conditions:
 - Physical illness: Cancer, cardiac disease, renal failure, diabetes, stroke, dementia etc.
 - Developmental issues in children & adolescents: SEN, biological or organic maldevelopment; mental health issue



Special features for placements in MSSU (Gen/Psy)

- Predominantly caseworks
- Can have groups/programmes
- Can be under SWD or HA
- 8:45 am to 5:30 pm
- Weekdays, daytime
- MSW/BSW students for MSSU/ Gen, MSW for MSSU/Psy



Special features for placements in MSP

- Patient Resource Centres (Daytime, mainly weekdays, both MSW or BSW students)
- Adolescent and Medical Centre, QE (Concurrent: Mondays, Fridays daytime and may be Thursdays pm to night, MSW students)



Special features for placements in MSP

- Cancer Care and Support Unit (weekday, daytime, MSW students)
- Apleichau outpatient clinic (HKU Family Medicine) (Any days of daytime Mon to Fri, both MSW or BSW students, only in concurrent)
- Hospice/QEH (only summer block, MSW students)



Nature and fieldwork assignment

- Casework predominantly in MSS (general) units
- Casework only in Apleichau outpatient clinic
- Group and programmes in PRC/HRC/CCSU, No casework
- AMC and MSSU (Psy) can have cases, groups and programmes



Challenges, learnings & Preparation

- Secondary setting with interdisciplinary approach
- Active engagement skills
- Cases are illness-related and require tangible services
- Group: psycho-educational, supportive, therapeutic
- Volunteer training and collaboration
- Community networking
- Patients empowerment



Challenges, learnings & preparation

- Understand the needs of service targets suffering from various illnesses or impairments
- Understand the carers' stress (the impact of illness families)
- Update with the financial subsidies and other community resources
- Understand the current development of the medical policy, primary care and community partnership



Challenges, learnings and preparations

- Efficient work pace and assessment skills
- Able to communicate effectively in Cantonese
- Update recordings according to SWD/HA format (precise, concise, accurate, clear follow-up plan)
- Creativity in group and programmes planning
- Proactive recruitment strategies



Challenges, learnings & preparations

- Attend the core volunteer training/Infection control training
- Check if got immunity of chicken pox and measles
- Update essential medical jargons, illnesses and revising knowledge of mental illness
- Be initiative
- Be independent
- Limited placement places
- May need to travel long distance
