## Background

- In 1986, the SWSA began collaboration with Zhongshan University in Guangzhou by placing MSW students in the Guangzhou Federation of Women and the Guangzhou Communist Youth
- Since 1998, the SWSA has already sent over 300 social work students in various placement settings in different countries and places, such as Australia, New Zealand, Canada, Germany, Singapore, UK, USA, Beijing, Guangzhou, Shanghai, Sichuan, Taiwan, India and Japan.

- gain new life experiences and take up challenges
- advance professional development
- engage in international exchange
- improve language proficiency
- widen career opportunities



#### 2025 Overseas Placement

#### Summer Block only for BSW & MSW

May 26/June 2 to August 9 - 23, 2025, 450 hours (10 - 12 weeks)

(\*Dates are just for reference; exact placement dates require further confirmation from the partner agency, and usually will last for 11-12 weeks to accumulate enough placement hours in foreign countries. Be prepared to start the placement in late May.)

## **Eligibility of Applicants**

- BSWFT3 and MSWFT1 (as at Sep 2024)
  - → Summer Block 2025 and submit application before 14 December, 2024
- BSWFT4 and MSWFT2 (as at Sep 2024)
  - → Summer Block 2025 and submit application before 14 December, 2024
- MSWPT3 (as at Sep 2024)
  - → Summer Block 2025 and submit application before 14 December, 2024
- MSWPT2 (as at Sep 2024)
  - → Apply duration changes of placement (apply for deferment of 2025-2026 concurrent placement to 2025 summer block placement)
  - → Summer Block 2025 and submit application in 14 Dec 2024

#### **Assessment Criteria**

- Good language proficiency (English and/or Putonghua)
- Good learning attitudes and interpersonal skills
- Maturity and independence
- Good health condition (both physically and psychologically)
- Academic performance
- Sufficient financial support to afford overseas expenses
- Recommendation from teachers

The above listed items are not exhaustive



### **Subsidy from Department**

• SWSA will offer fixed subsidy for the successful applicants, it covers part of the expenses of the placement (HK\$12,000 for USA, UK and Canada, HK\$11,000 for Australia, HK\$5,500 for Taiwan, Singapore), around 1/3 of the total expenses in the past.

- 1978 Alumni Travel Award and Project Fund (Additional subsidy for needy students)

#### **Administrative Tasks**

- Visa application
- Insurance package
- Medical check up
- Applying for criminal record clearance (depends on countries)
- Applying for funding / subsidy

#### **Administrative Tasks**

- Completing routine fieldwork requirements on assignments
- Handling of expenses reimbursement (financial report) as to get SWSA subsidy
- Submitting students' summary report (not less than 4 pages)
